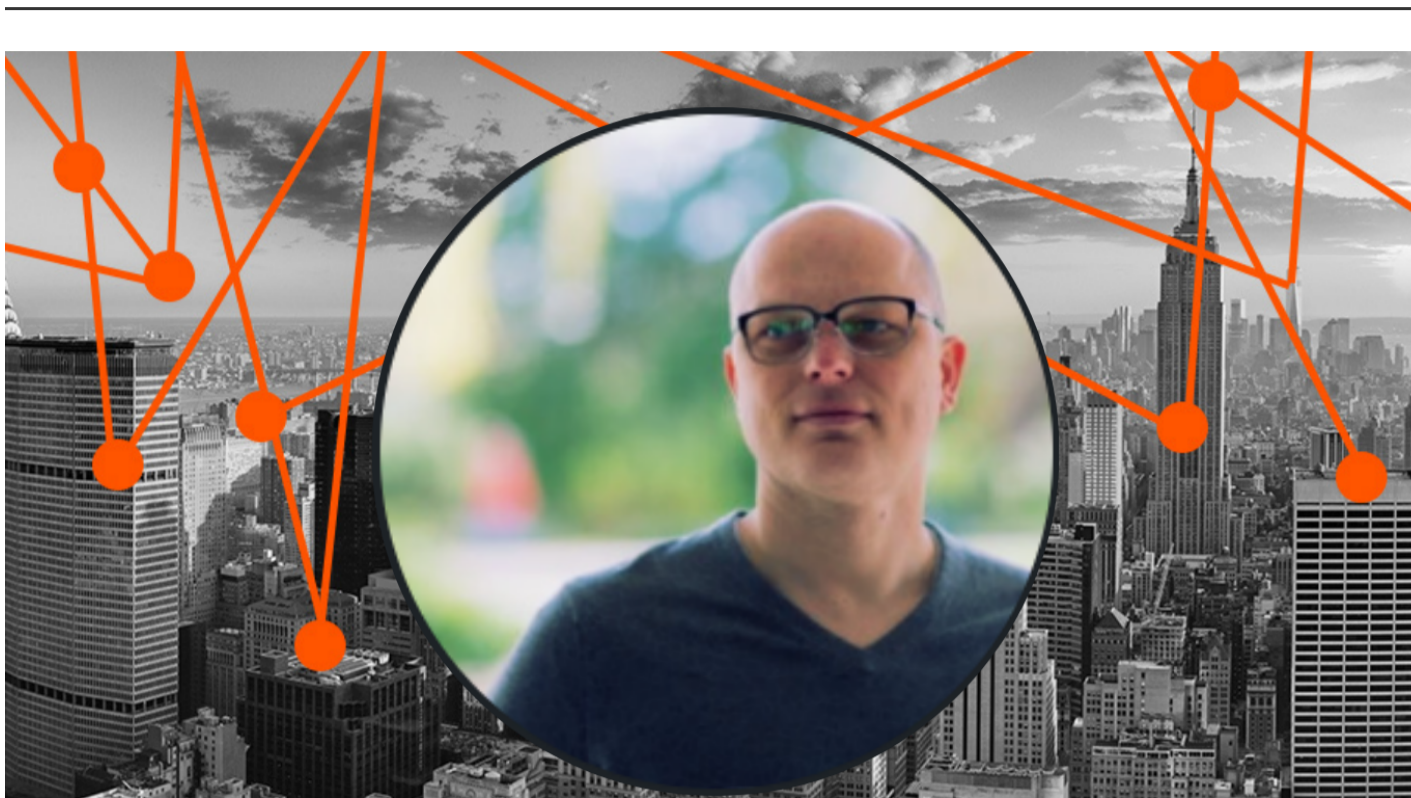

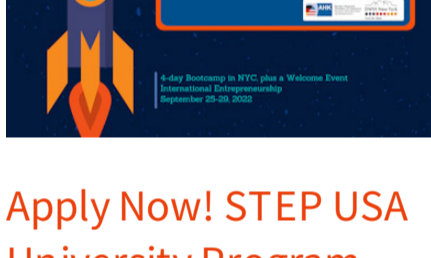

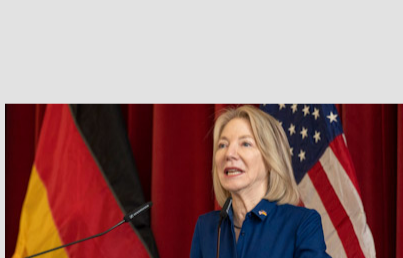

Making Artificial Intelligence Sustainable

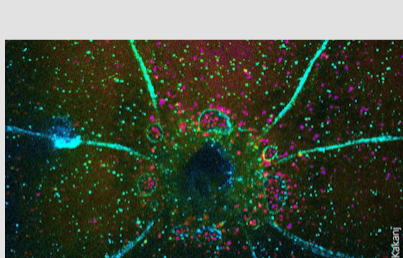
