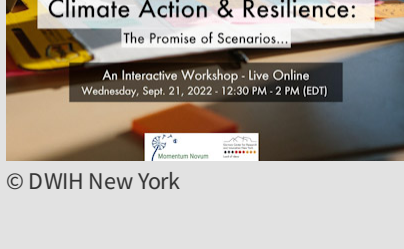

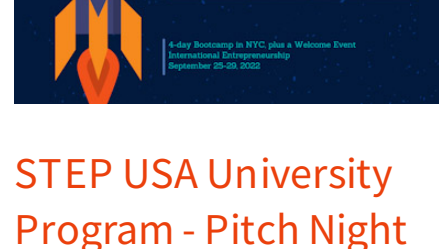

Around 10 million euros over four years for research into the genetic foundations and key mechanisms with which plants adapt to changes in their environment.

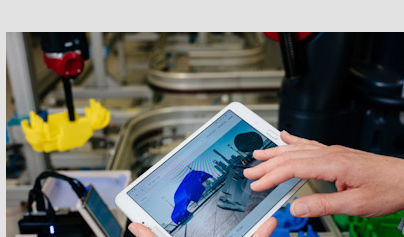

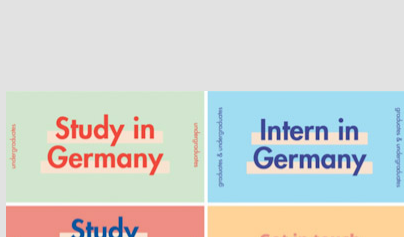
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### Panel Discussion: Engineering Education for the 21st Century

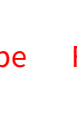
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### Upcoming Study and Internship Opportunities for Undergraduates at German Universities of Applied Sciences

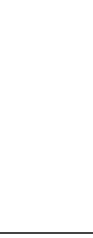
