### Social Change More Important Than Physical Tipping Points

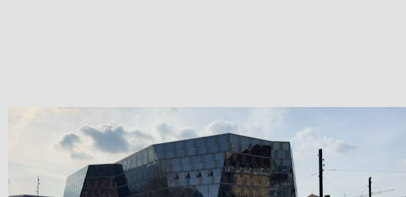

### More Sustainability, Less Waste: Intelligent Production Facilities For Small Baked Goods

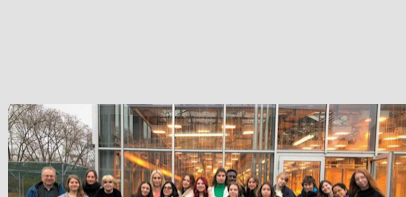
A consortium from research and industry, including Paderborn University, is examining how the manufacturing process for rolls, doughnuts, pretzels could be made more sustainable.
