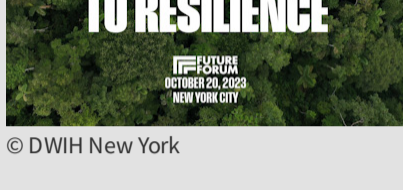

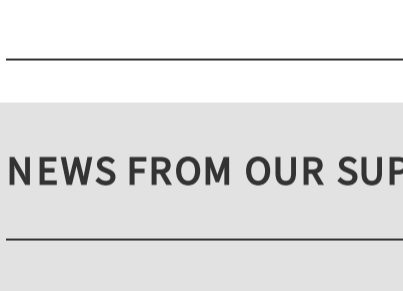

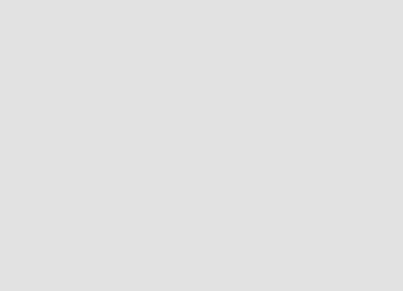

New Center for the Co-Constructive Artificial Intelligence

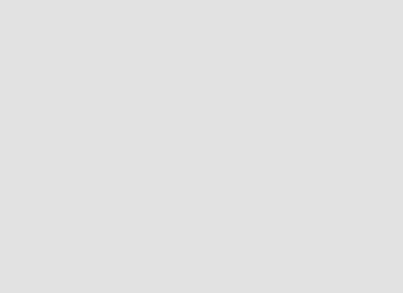

Prof. Renée Tribble on the Planning and Implementation of Citizen Science Projects

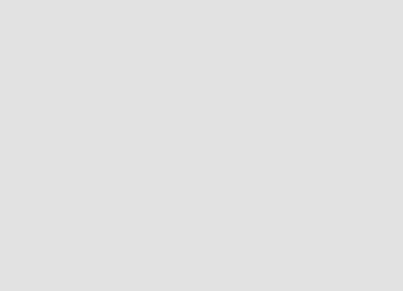

University of Cologne Adopts Holistic Sustainability Strategy

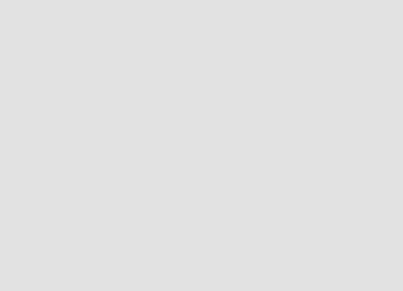

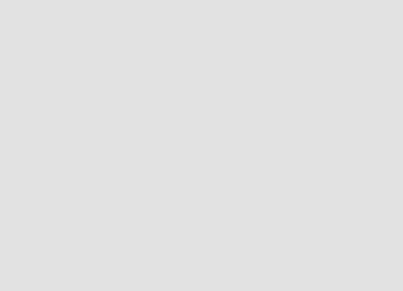

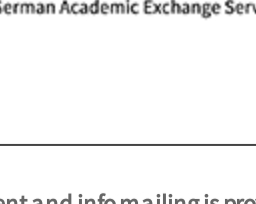
